This person could be an employer, minister, volunteer coordinator, etc. Please ask the person providing this recommendation for you to return it to you so that you can include it with your packet by the deadline.

Please provide a copy of your most recent transcript. If you are coming from a foreign school or university you should submit a copy of your professional evaluation with GPA calculation.
